

Existing Units

General Insight

- Alluring Glass' method of Completely Frameless is to laser template the space and have the glass fabricated to the contour of the surface, eliminating the need for track and/or channel.
- Holes have been drilled into the tile to fasten your existing shower.
- Obviously, when we remove the existing shower, holes will be exposed.
 - We typically fill the holes with silicone to prevent water.
- Additionally, depending on how long the existing unit has been there, discoloration could be present under the existing track.
 - Again, if there is discoloration, many clients just clean it the best they can and understand the frameless options reduce the amount of metal on the enclosure, substantially.
- If while removing the existing until, our craftsman notice any major tile issues, they of course will stop.
 - In the rare situations that you may need tile repaired, we can provide some referrals of trusted craftsmen to perform that work.
- Pricing, while we can get exact numbers for updating both units, from a budgetary standpoint, I'd plan on the 4k range total, for two new complexly frameless enclosures.

Action Steps

- We will provide an exact quote to remove and upgrade the shower with to a completely frameless, no track or channel, application.
- This requires us to remove the existing shower, and laser template for the frameless glass.
- After removal of the existing shower, you will see if there is any damage to the tile and or unsightly discoloration that needs to be addressed.
- Upon our return, with the frameless glass, we will fill existing holes with silicone and install the frameless application.
